



Directive for league championships

1. Introduction

League shoots are deemed to a preparatory exercise towards participating in provincial and national championships. The results of league championships furthermore count towards the selection of Free State teams to participate at national and provincial levels.

However, although league shoots were only part of the serious shooter's exercise regime, with the latest requirement of shooters having to qualify for dedicated status in order to motivate for the retention of their firearms, league shoots have become part of the not-so-serious shooters' diary.

League scores will also be utilized to establish a ranking for BMSSC as well as to determine the trophy winners at the year-end function.

2. Rules

- ✦ A league event will comprise of 20 shots per IMSSU or SAMSSA event – 5 shots per distance.
- ✦ The appropriate IMSSU standards will be used.
- ✦ The appropriate times should be adhered to i.e. 2 minutes for handguns and 2½ minutes for rifles.
- ✦ Scorekeeping should be kept in line with IMSSU rules.
- ✦ Shooters can choose to shoot a league at any time during practice sessions, be that on a Saturday or a Wednesday (if range is open), provided that the following is adhered to:
 - The scores should be kept by another person and the range officer on duty has to co-sign. No one will be allowed to score for themselves. It is the responsibility of each competitor to arrange for a scorekeeper. Scorecards that do not contain 3 signatures will not be valid.
 - All safety rules are being adhered to, especially the wearing of ear and eye protection.
 - The appropriate times should be adhered to i.e. 2 minutes for handguns and 2½ minutes for rifles.
- ✦ The following targets will be set up on Saturdays by the club committee (unless due to unforeseen difficulties):
 - Small Bore Handgun
 - Field Pistol
 - Sport Handgun
 - Small Bore Rifle

The targets for Big Bore Rifle, Big Bore Handgun, Varmint Rifle, Varmint Handgun, Air Pistol and Air Rifle will be available to each member to set for themselves.

On Wednesdays the onus will be on the shooters to set targets for themselves.

- ✦ The members are advised to shoot aggregate scores, since those will be used when selecting members for the various teams.
- ✦ The safety coordinator has the right to inspect any firearms being used in the shoot.
- ✦ A member may only participate in the championship after the league fee has been paid.
- ✦ Only fully paid members will be allowed to participate in a league shoot
- ✦ A shooter can only participate once a month in any particular event.
- ✦ Children under the age of 18 can only participate under the direct supervision of the firearm license holder.
